Education Week consists of 5 modules to be completed by participants in order to obtain the European Spine Course Diploma (ESCD). The ESCD is now respected on a European level by many spinal societies and federations and is officially recognised as equivalent to the Diploma in Germany. The next Education Week will take place on 19—23 June 2017 at the IRCAD in Strasbourg.



Those who have already obtained their ESCD are eligible to attend the Advanced Courses to earn the Advanced Diploma. Modules on *Extended Indications, Advanced Operative Techniques and Complications and Management* will be offered from 9–11 January 2017 at the IRCAD in Strasbourg.
