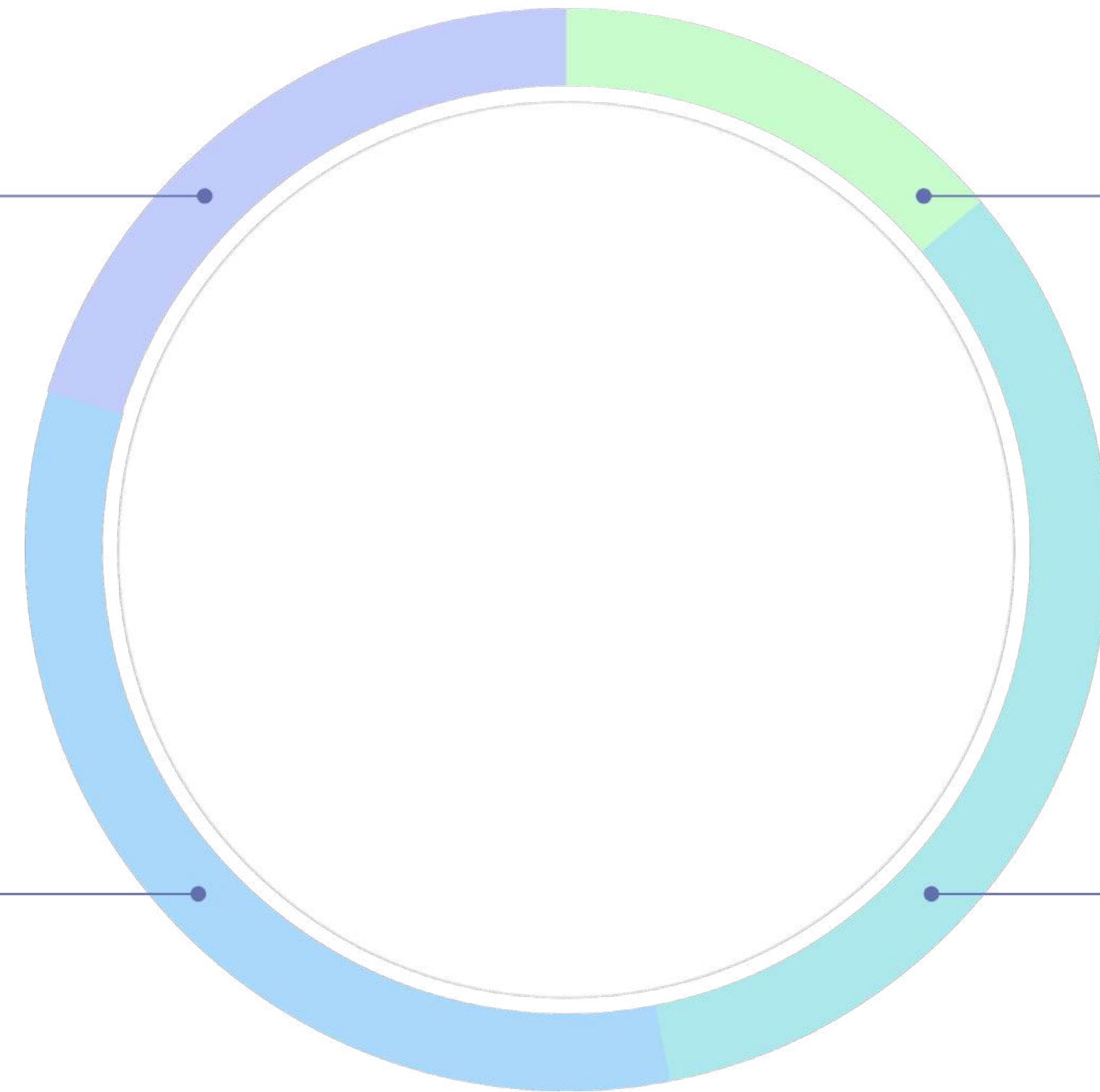

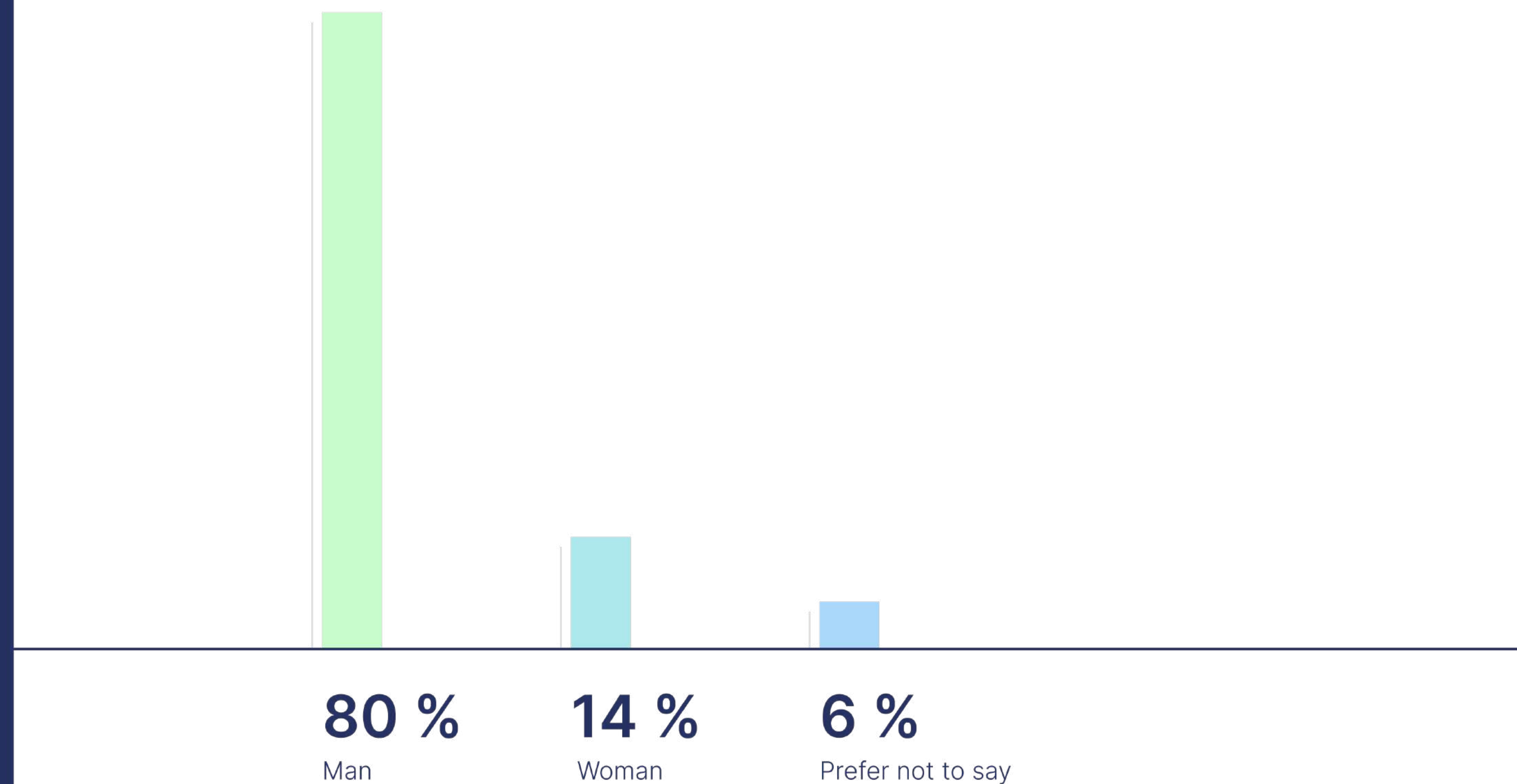

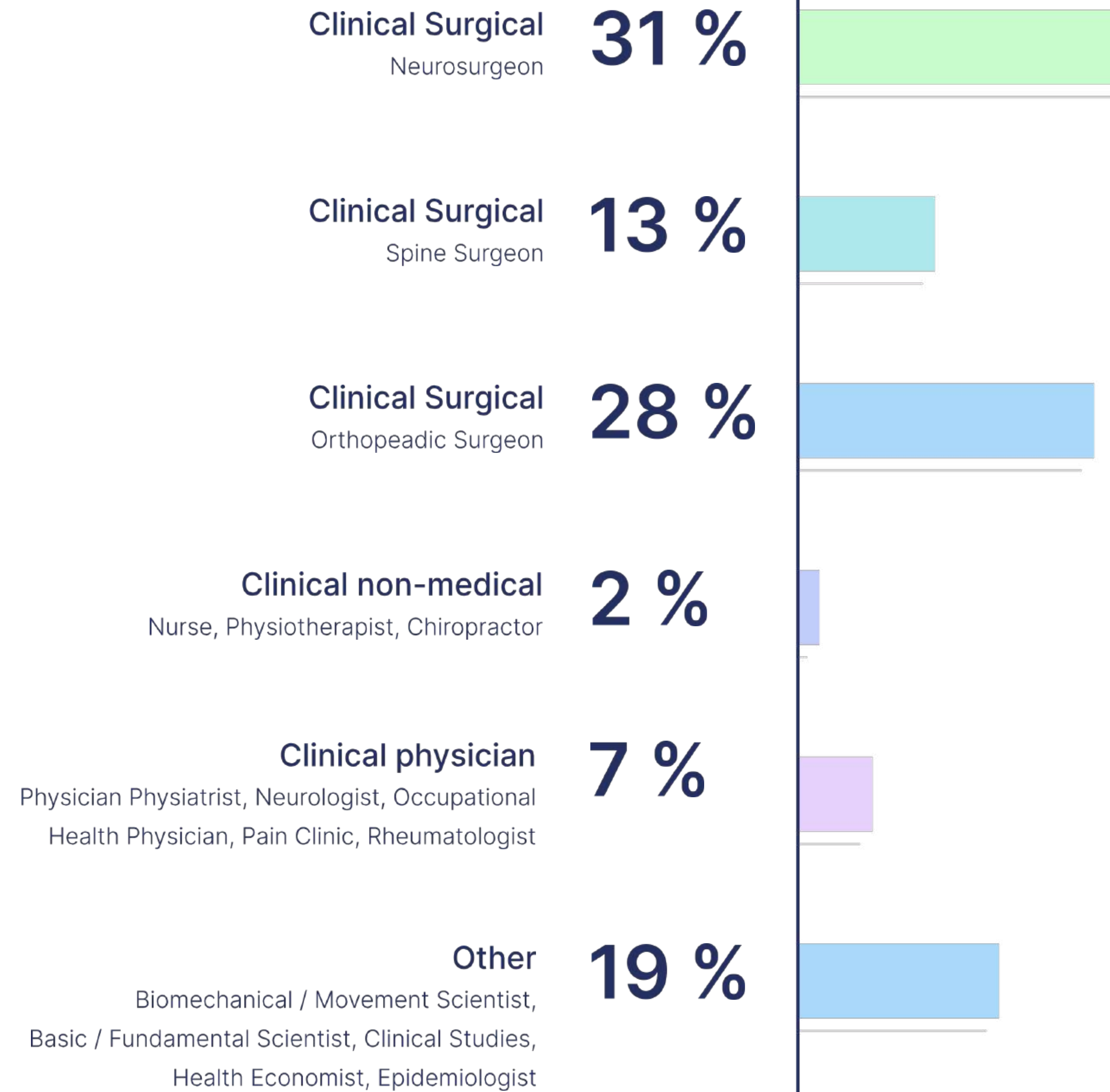

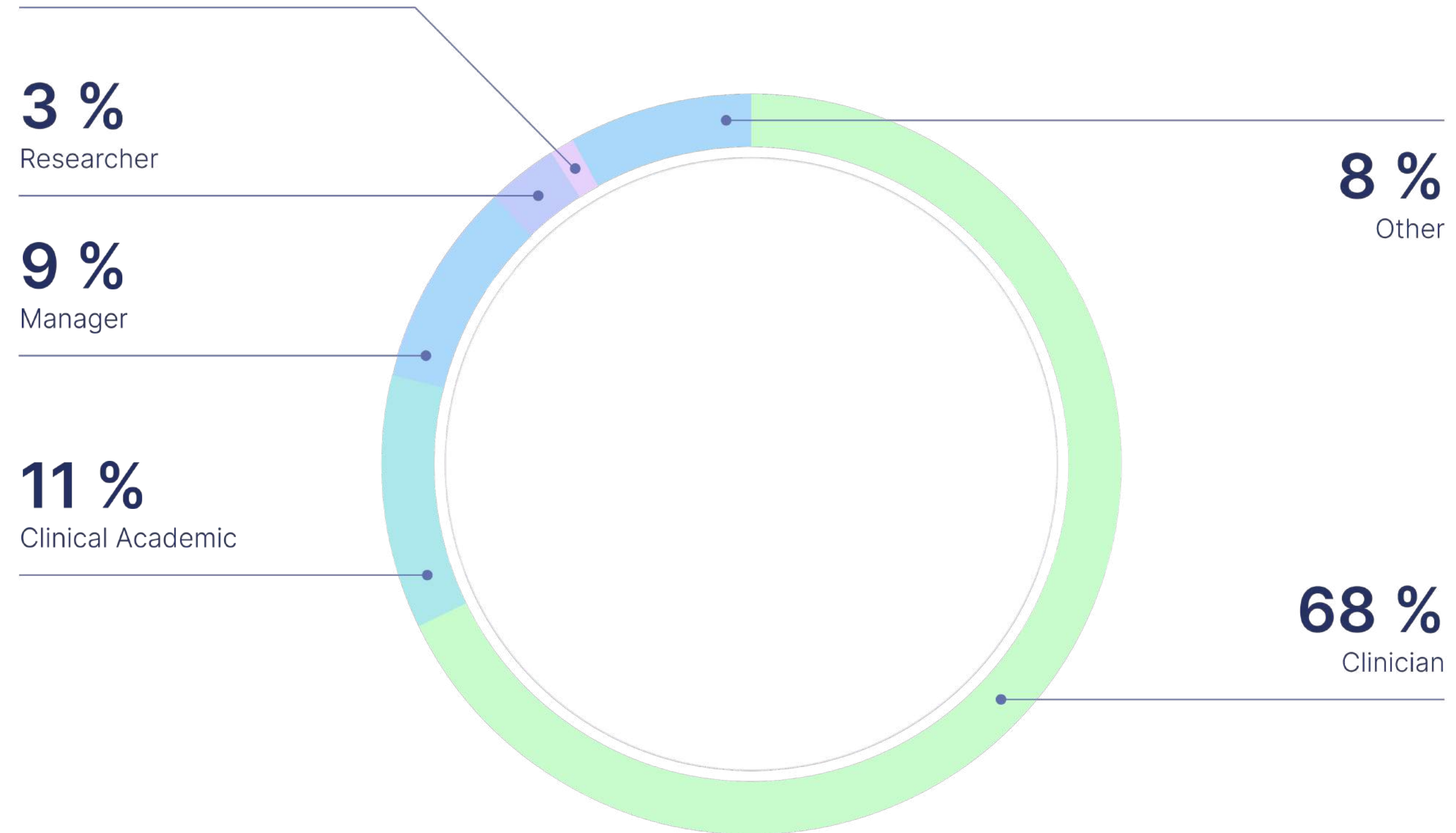

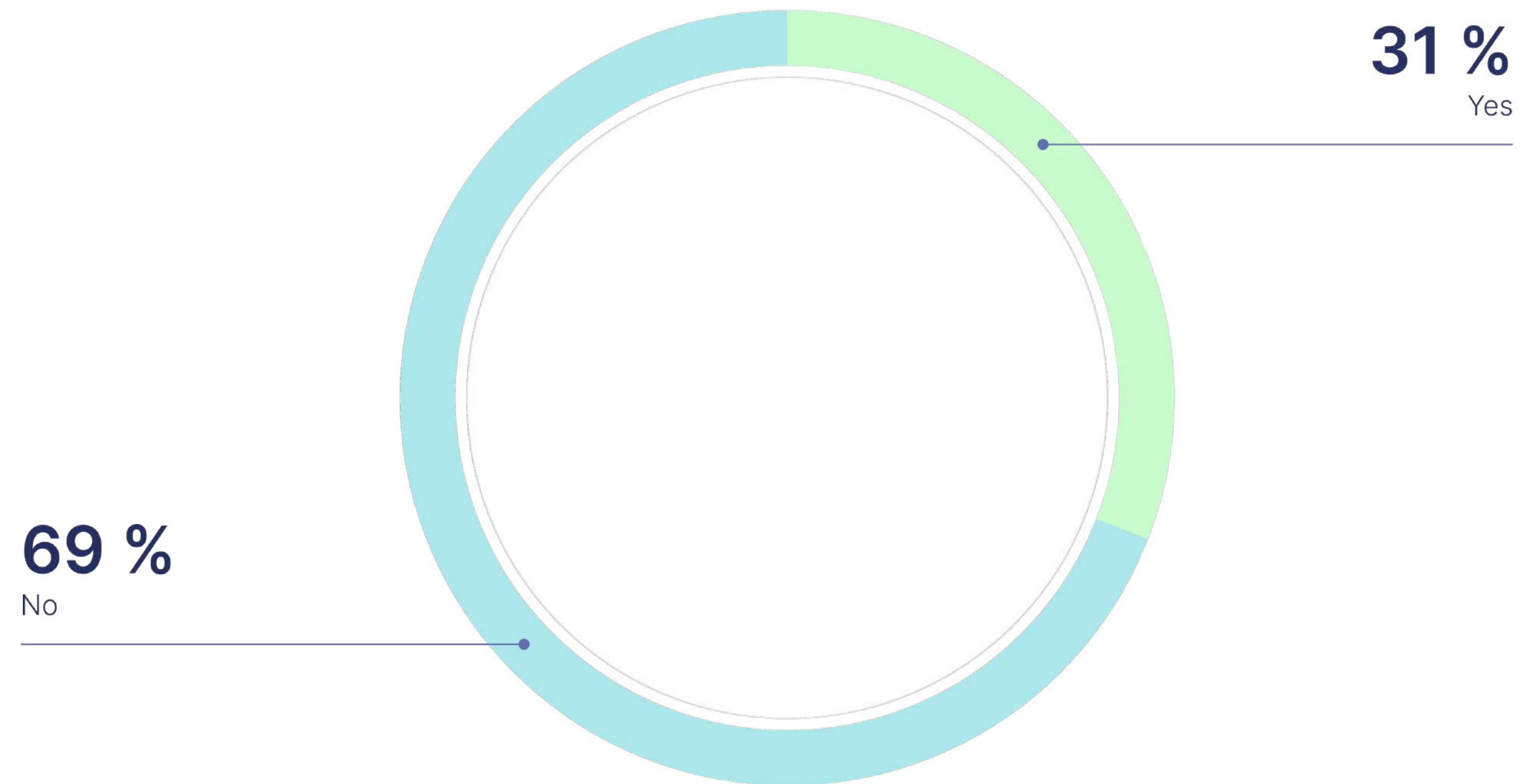

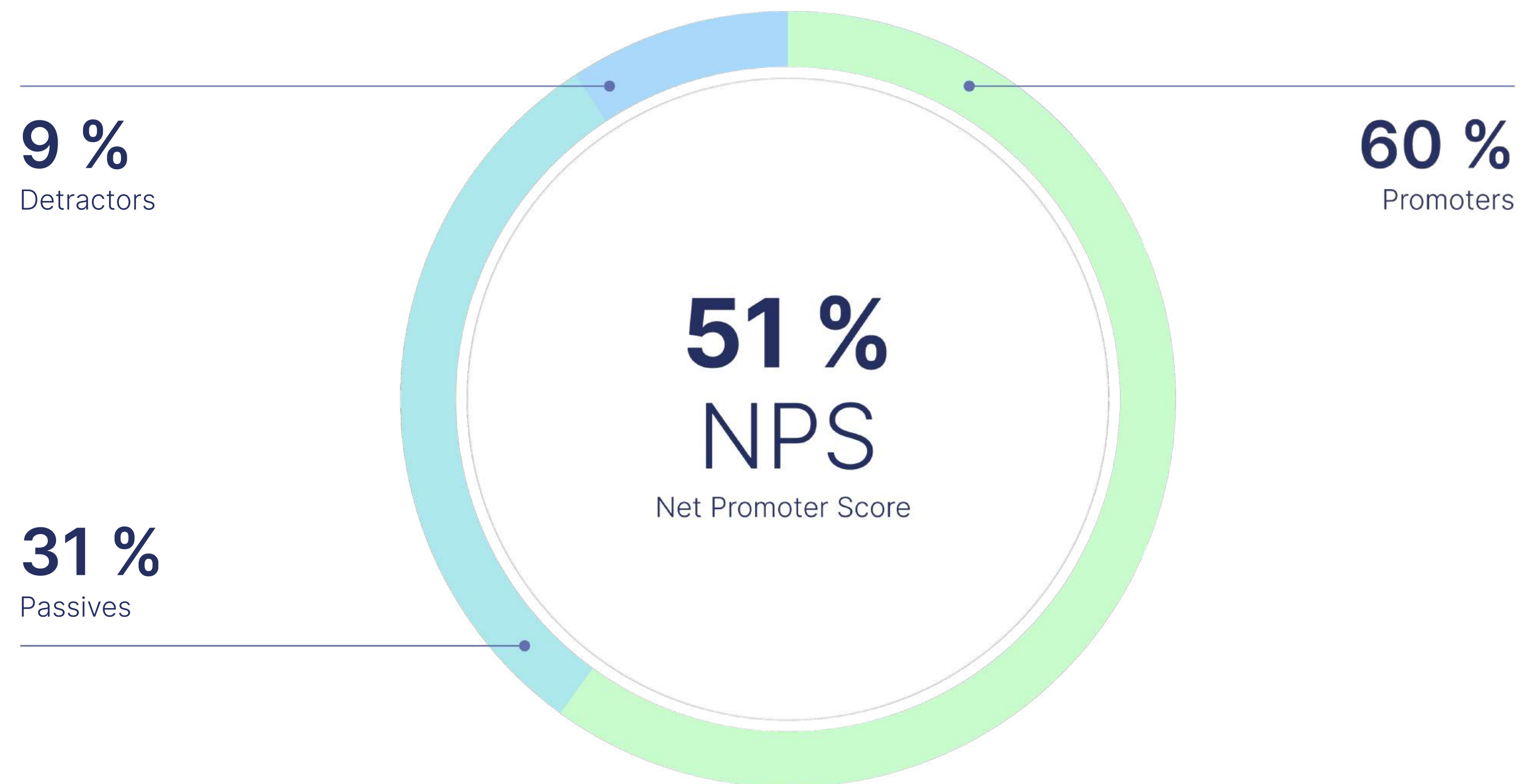

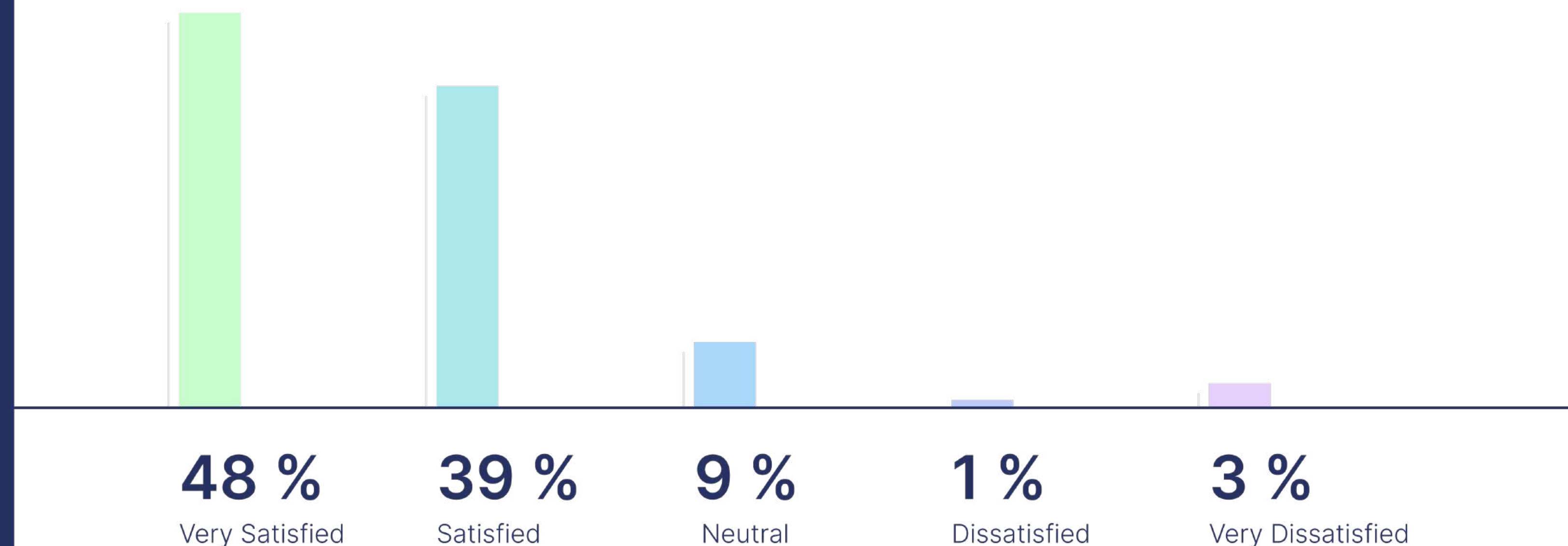
# How likely are you to recommend the EUROSPINE Annual Meeting to a colleague?

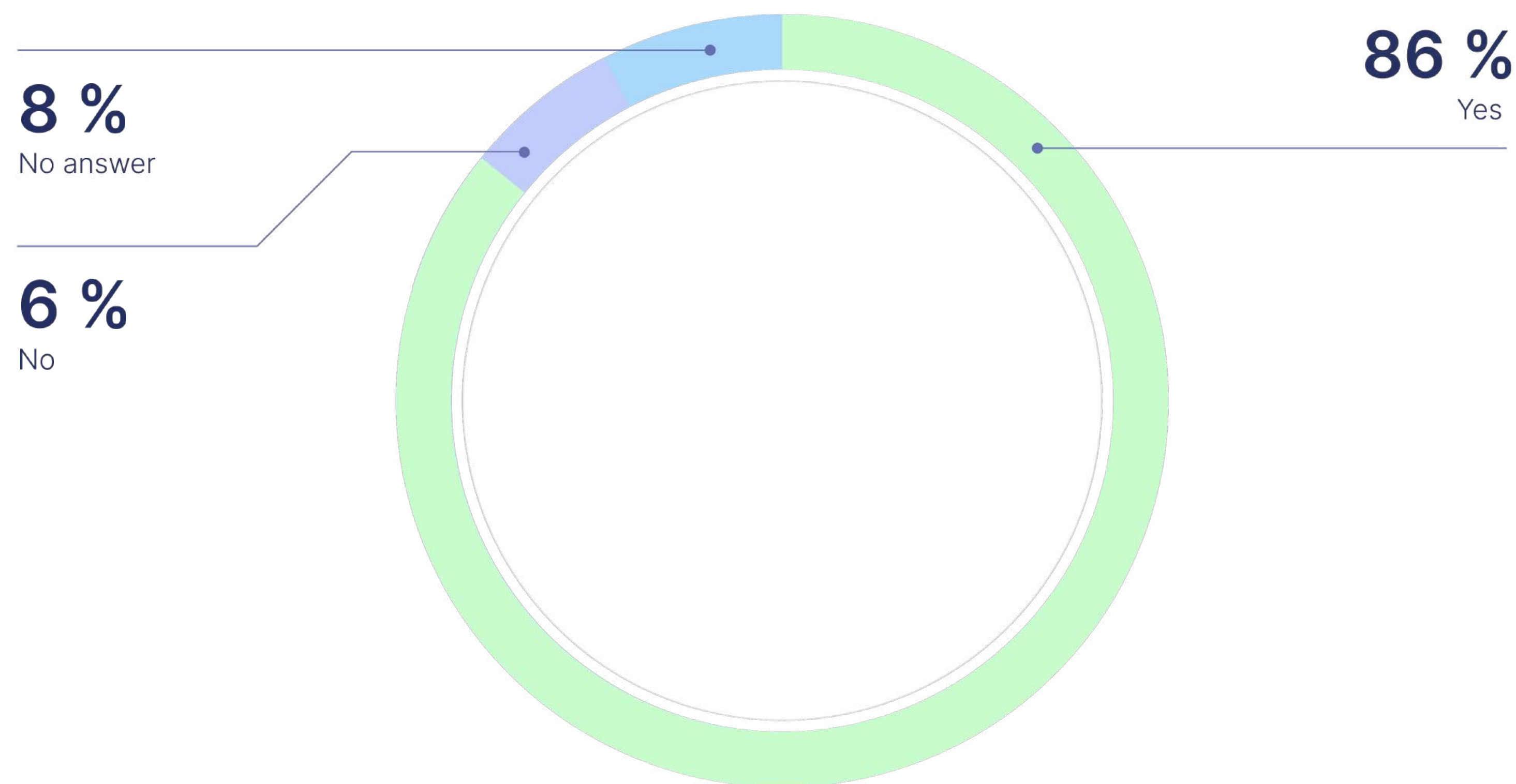

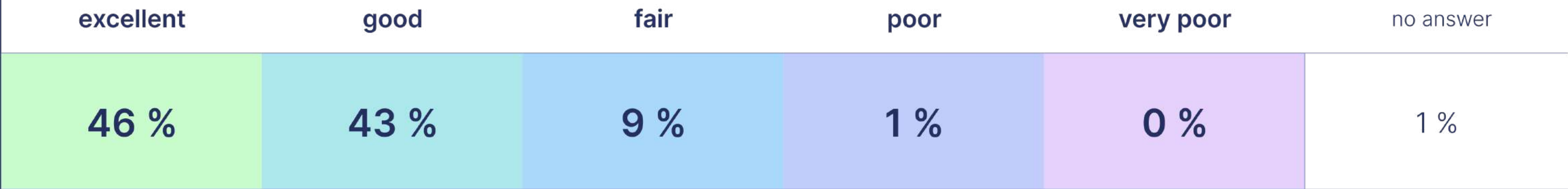

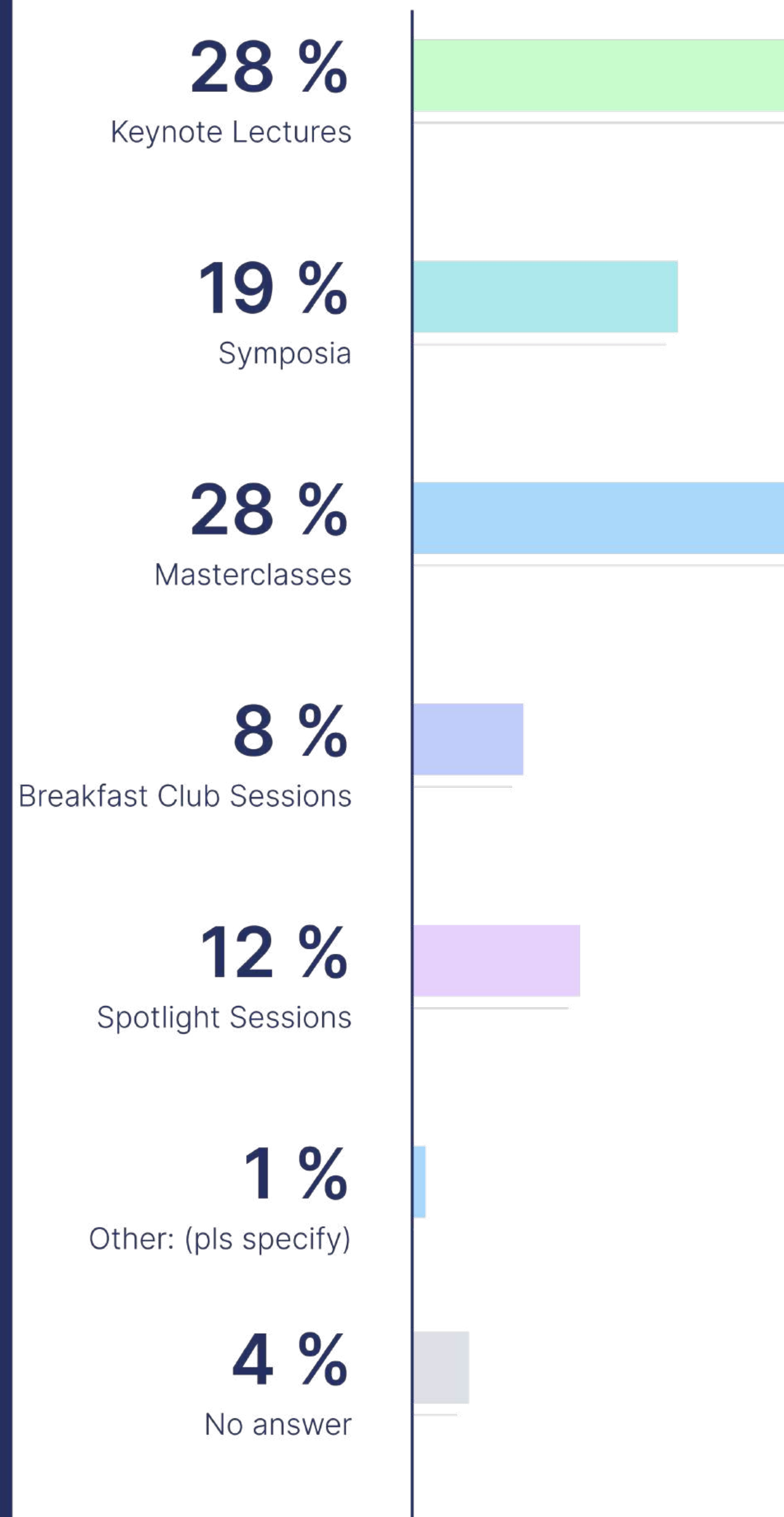

Practical sessions like 'How I do it' videos would be extremely useful.

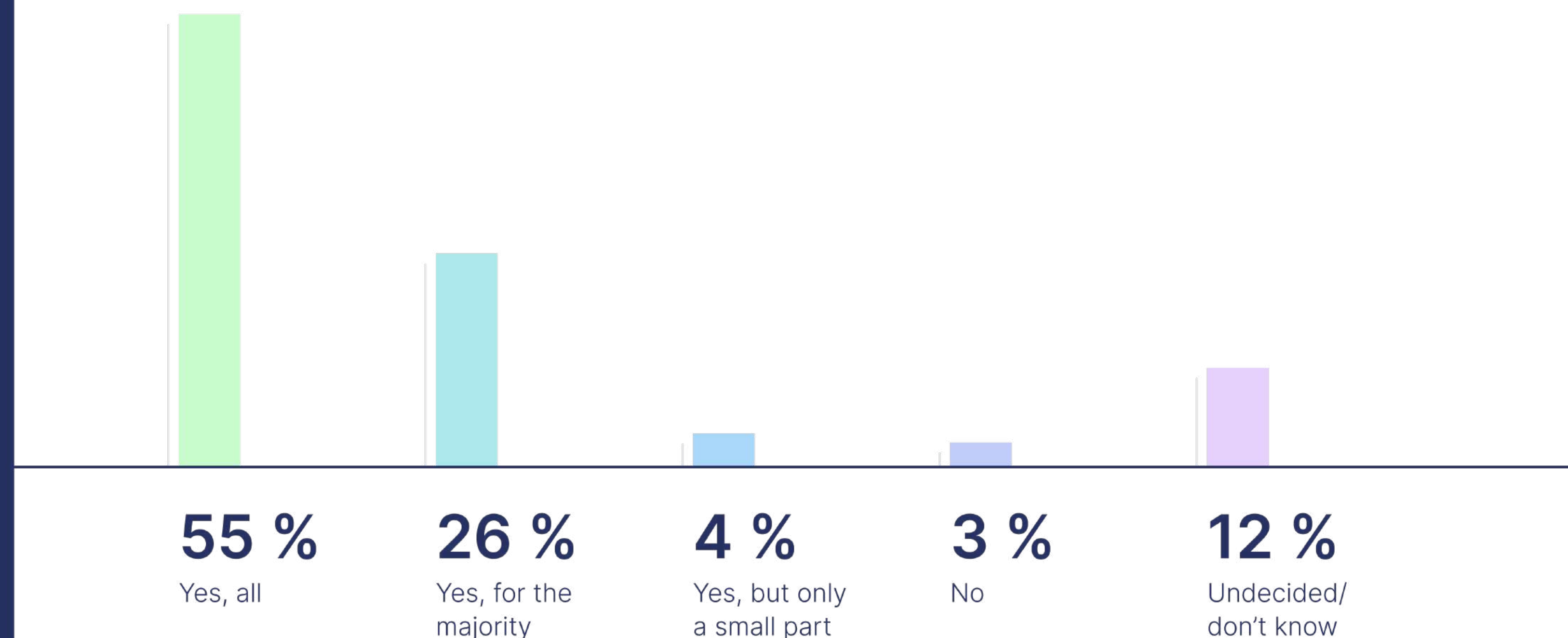


Future-oriented themes like robotics and artificial intelligence would be exciting.

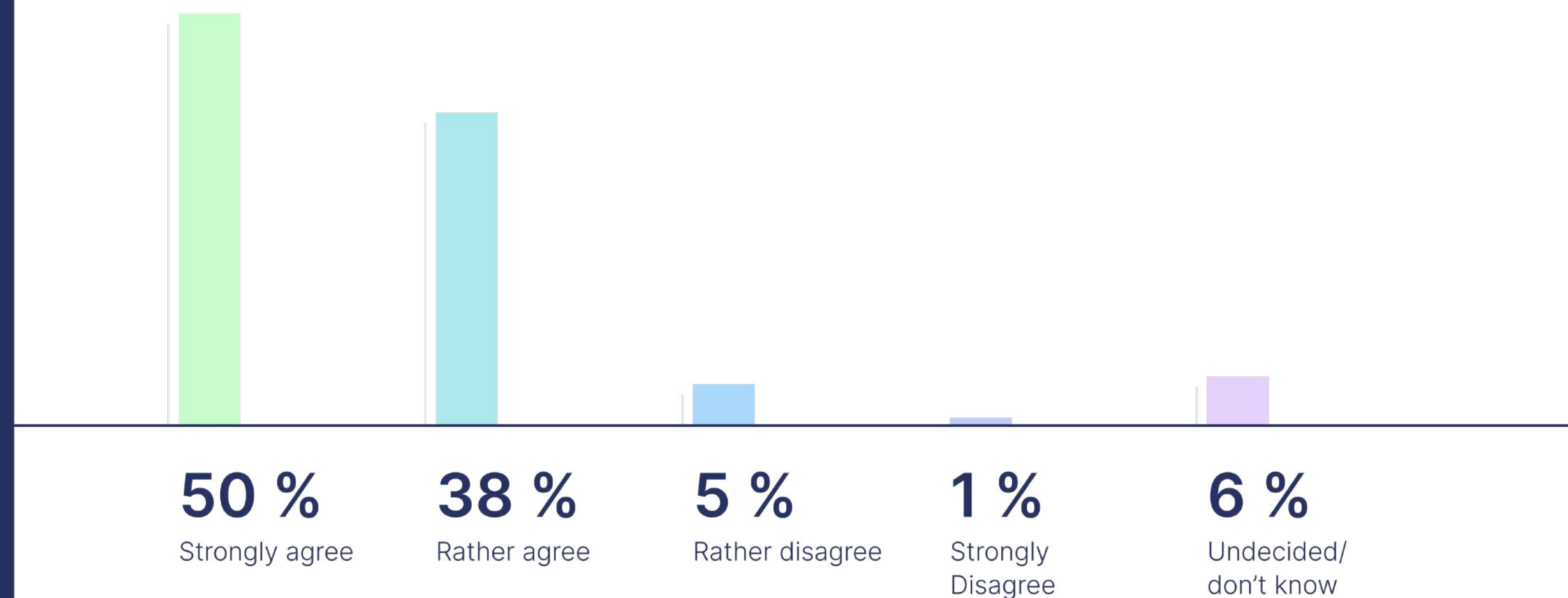

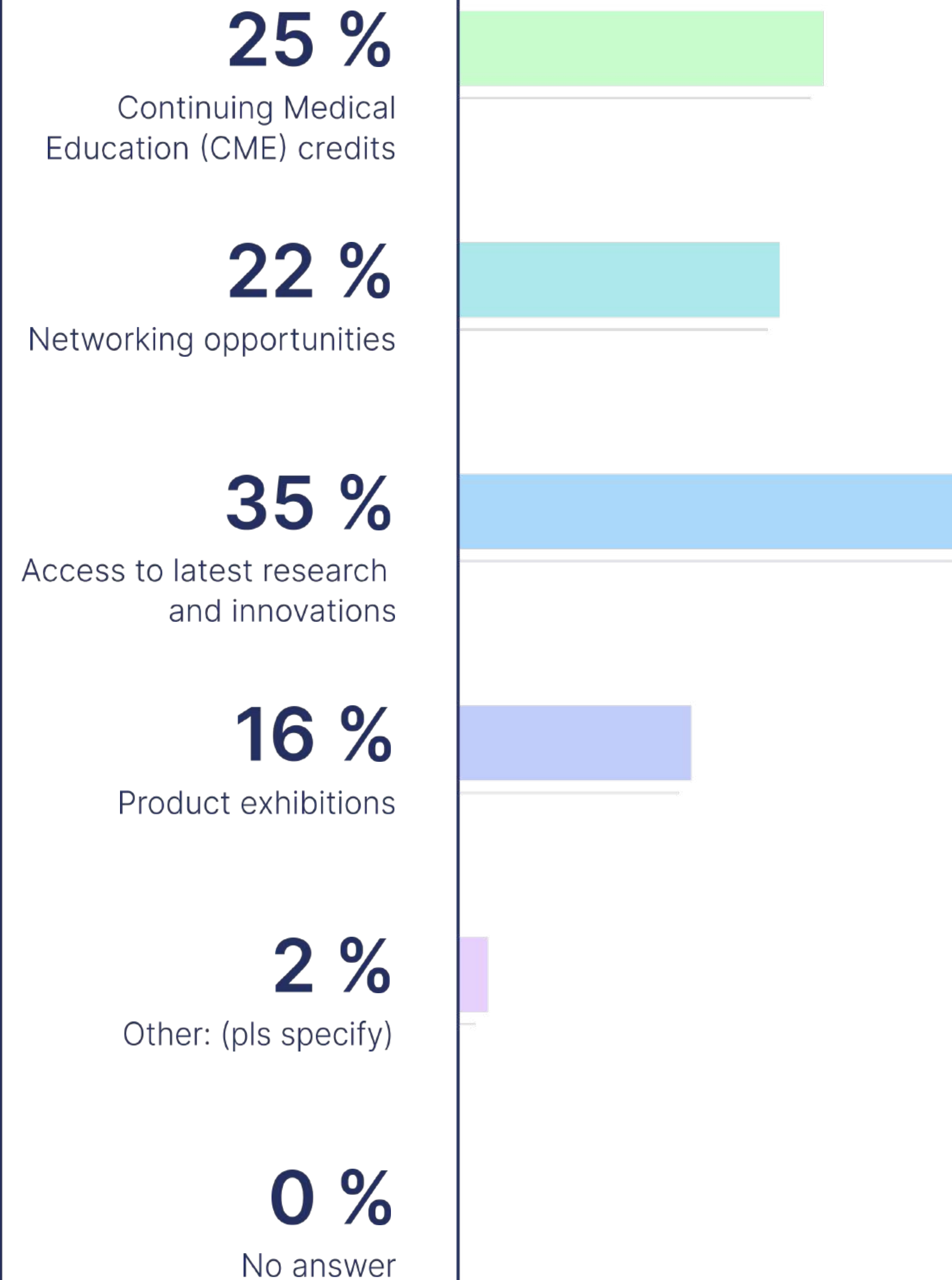

Providing multi-language support for international attendees would be a great idea.

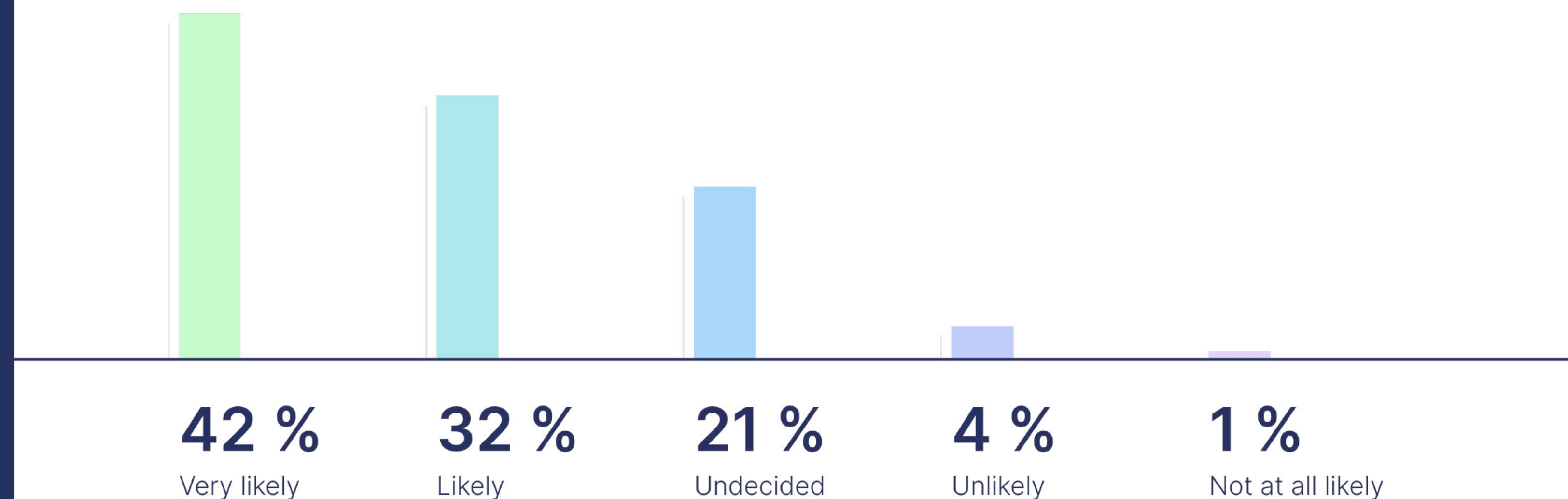


Shorter and more focused sessions could help maintain engagement throughout the day.
