The taxi fare is flat at 60€ (64\$) during the daytime (05:00 am − 00:00 am) and 70€ (75\$) during the night shift, while the total journey to Athens city center lasts 35-40 minutes under normal traffic conditions. You may use the Free Now App or Uber App instead; but be informed that they often order normal yellow taxis.
- Train: Athens International Airport is connected via suburban rail to Athens Central Railway Station (Larissis Station), Port of Pireaus and Kiato.
- Metro: You can also take Athens Metro Line 3 (blue line) at the Airport's Railway Station, which departs every 35 minutes towards the city centre. The trip lasts approximately 50 minutes. Upon reaching Metro Station "Syntagma", change to metro line 2 (red line) heading towards "Elliniko". Hop off at the next station "Akropoli".
